CLASS THREE AND FOUR

You and Your Dog

The most basic and essential foundation of training begins with the daily interactions between you and your pet. Bonding with your dog will enhance and help establish boundaries so you can learn what to expect from your pet and what your pet expects from you. Introduction to command hand signals, for the sit, stay and down positions. Appropriate behavior correction techniques using positive reinforcement. Understanding the importance of the preparatory command(Your dog's name)
