Matt Liability Release Form

Matts are areas of severely tangled coat. This usually happens when your pet has not been brushed and combed as often and thoroughly as his/her coat requires. Other things that may cause, or worsen matting, are: frequent bathing or wet weather, lack of regular professional grooming, and bathing already tangled coat. Water is a catalyst in matt forming. Puppies tend to shed their baby coat and grow the adult coat between the ages of 9 and 14 months. At this stage, it is especially important to maintain the coat.

Once your pet's coat is matted, there are not as many options for grooming. The two methods of removing matts are dematting and shaving or clipping. If the matts are few, and relatively small, they can often be removed without removing too much coat. If the matts are severe, the entire coat, or the matted sections must be removed by shaving or "stripping" the matts off.

The processes of dematting can be dangerous and/or uncomfortable for your pet. Some of the risks involved include: brush "burn", clipper irritation, nicks, cuts, and abrasions. While your pet is in our care, your groomer will take every precaution, and use meticulous care to avoid any of these occurrences. However, you must recognize that, because of your pet's coat condition, they are still at risk.

On some occasions, if a pet's coat is badly matted, the dematting process may result in a cut which may look odd at first. However, please rest assured that your pet will be significantly more comfortable after removal of these painful matts, and that his cut will grow out quickly and easily if you maintain it as instructed by our groomer.

By signing below, you are accepting responsibility for any injuries, or irritations that may occur as a result of removing matted coat. There will be additional charges for dematting.
